General

This Compost Processing and Sales Facility is operated by the City of Cheyenne.

Facility Rules

- ◆ Leave no trash. Empty all containers. A dumpster is available for disposal of all non reusable containers.
- ◆ Obtain license plate number to report any inappropriate activity, 637-6440. All information will be kept confidential.
- ◆ Site manager reserves the right to refuse drop-off of any load.
- ◆ Any load brought to the Public Compost Facility requires a tarp.
- ◆ Businesses dropping off pallets will be charged \$.25 per pallet.
- ◆ There will be a fee of \$5.00 per cubic yard to drop off manure from businesses or residents. The 1st pick up load or 3 cubic yards is free per day. 3 yards max on Sunday.

Method of Payment

Cash, Checks, and Credit Cards are accepted. Charge accounts may be established and are encouraged. Please ask attendant for application.

Materials & Prices

Drop-off

No Commercial drop offs on Sundays.

There is **No CHARGE** for dropping off yard wastes to the Compost Facility 3714 Windmill Rd. Section 8.44.070 of the city code requires all persons transporting refuse or recyclable material must cover the load with a tarp.

Materials Received

- ◆ Limbs, brush, wood chips
- ◆ Tree trunks cut less than 6' in length
- ◆ Clean pallets (No paint, chipboard, plywood, metal straps or plastic.
- ◆ Grass clippings, prunings, and weeds
- ◆ Leaves (may contain very small twigs)
- ◆ Livestock manure and bedding
- ◆ Sod, topsoil, and other misc., wastes

Materials Not Accepted

- ◆ Materials treated w/clopyralid pesticides
- ◆ Painted or treated lumber, railroad ties
- ◆ Loads mixed w/trash or unlike materials
- ◆ Tree or bush roots or Trunks larger than 12" in diameter need to go to the landfill

| Produced from composted manure and stable bedding materials, leaves, grass clippings, and ground wood. Used to increase water holding capacity and improve soil structure when planting trees, grass, and bedding plants. Also used to top-dress existing turf grass, potted, and bedding plants; to provide soil nutrients, organics, and beneficial soil microbes. Use as soil preparation for new sod and transplants into beds or pots. | | |
| ◆ Single Grind Mulch | \$.37 | \$12.48 |
| Wood chip mulch produced from ground brush and limbs. Use as decorative cover around trees, shrubs, and other plants to hold in moisture and limit growth of grass and weeds. | | |
| ◆ Double Grind Mulch | \$.47 | \$16.64 |
| Wood chip mulch ground extra fine. Used for decorative mulch cover and natural weed barrier. | | |
| ◆ Double Take Wood Mulch | \$.89 | \$33.28 |
| Double grind wood mulch colored Rose and kiln dried wood mulch colored Red. Colorant is non toxic and safe for kids, pets, plants, and the environment. | | |


