### **Quick Reference Information**

- 1. Please call the sanitation department at 637-6440 with any questions, comments, or concerns.
- 2. Place only acceptable recycling material in the container. Glass is not acceptable, it contaminates the recycling materials—see list inside brochure. Do not bag the material.
- 3. Recyclables are picked up every other week. This may change to a weekly pick up if needed. Set the container at the edge of the street with the wheels toward the curb. Recyclable pick up will be at the curb or in the alley. The container must be at least two feet from any car or obstacle. The container must be removed from the curb after pick up.
- 4. During the windy season January thru April, residents may bag their recyclables to help prevent items from blowing around and creating a litter problem.

### PROGRAM DETAILS

- If Monday should be a holiday, your recycling collection will be picked up the Saturday before. If a holiday should fall on Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, or Friday your recycling collection will be picked up the following Saturday.
- All recyclables set out for pick up should be placed in the provided container for every other week pick up. **Do not bag material placed in the container.**
- Your trash and recycle containers will be picked up the same day. However, recycle is picked up every other week. See our web site at: www.cheyennecity.org for a map and calendar for your pick up week. The containers must have at least two feet of clearance between them. Two different trucks will be out, one for trash and one for recycle. One may come in the morning and/

or one in the afternoon. Both trucks will pick up

between 6:30 a.m. and 2:30 p.m.

The following items **MAY** be placed in your containers:

- Newspapers, Magazines, Phone Books, and Catalogs
- Brown Paper Bags
- Cardboard Containers (flatten & cut into 2'x2' or smaller pieces)
- Cereal Boxes
- Wax Coated Milk & Juice Containers
- Plastics #1 thru #7. (no plastic bags)
- Steel Cans
- Aluminum Cans, Foil, and Pie Tins
- Junk Mail
- Office Pack

The following items **MAY NOT** be placed in your container:

- No Plastic Bags
- No Garbage
- No Styrofoam
- No Glass
- No Mirrors, Light Bulbs, or Window Glass
- No Ceramics (dishes or cups)
- No Hazardous Materials (paint, motor oil, antifreeze, and batteries of any size.)
