NEW SOD/SEED APPLICATION

Organic matter increases the water holding capacity of the soil and enhances root development by improving the texture of the soil. Proper soil preparation allows moisture to be held in soils longer, resulting in reduced irrigation requirements.

PERMIT REQUIREMENTS: A minimum of 3.5 cubic yards of organic material per 1,000 square feet of soil must be incorporated to a depth of at least six inches by tilling, disking or other suitable method. Examples of acceptable organic matter include compost, aged composted manure or Sphagnum peat moss.

A permit is issued in good faith, assuming that the above requirements are met. Sites utilizing a permit are subject to inspection and the permit may be revoked if following inspection, the site is determined to not have been properly amended.
