I. Suspended Designated Corridors

24-5 Central Avenue (8th Ave to Pershing Blvd)

Status: Suspended since 9/30/25. Radar devices remain operational, but no targeted enforcement.

Next Steps: Edge line striping planned for summer 2026 to create 11' lanes. Recommendation is to keep suspended until striping is complete; consider activating enforcement one month prior for before/after comparison.

II. Petitions Under Review

26-2 Poder Secondary School

Concern: Streets are very narrow, need one-way signs to ease the flow of traffic for parents dropping off and picking up students.

Status: It is the Traffic Engineer's recommendation given the nature of the request and the need for a comprehensive review during active school operations; it is recommended that this item be scheduled for consideration no earlier than the November or December 2026 meeting cycle. This timeframe would allow staff adequate opportunity to observe conditions during the fall school semester, gather data, coordinate with stakeholders, and evaluate potential impacts associated with any proposed traffic pattern changes
