This Addendum Number One supersedes all previous instructions pertaining to the items listed:

Questions & Responses:

- Q1: Have you conducted counts in the past with a consultant?
- A1: Yes
- Q2: *Relating to Q1* If so, who is the incumbent(s)?
- A2: All Traffic Data Services, Inc.
- Q3: Can we obtain prior pricing?
- A3: 162-ADT (24hr Volumes) for \$12,150.00
- Q4: Would it be possible to get a copy of the list of traffic count locations with lat/long coordinates?

A4: The wining consultant will receive count locations using either GIS shape file or Google Earth klm file. If wining consultant would like lat/long coordinates, we can be provide them.

Q5: What vehicle classification groups are needed for the 10 associated locations?

A5: Class 1 – Motorcycles
Class 2 – Passenger Cars
Class 3 – Two-Axle Four Tire Single-Unit Vehicles
Class 4 – Busses
Class 5 – Two-Axle, Six-Tire, Single-Unit Trucks
Class 6 – Three-Axle Single Unit Trucks
Class 7 – Four or More Axle Single Unit Trucks
Class 8 – Four or Fewer Axle Single Unit Trucks
Class 9 – Five-Axle Single-Trailer Trucks
Class 10 – Six or More Axle Single-Trailer Trucks
Class 11 – Five or Fewer Axle Multi-Trailer Trucks
Class 12 – Six-Axle Multi-Trailer Trucks
Class 13 – Seven or More Axle Multi Trailer Trucks

Q6: What is driving the October 23rd deadline to have the counts completed?

A6: We have all counts completed in either April-May or September-October of each year.

Q7: Do counts need to be submitted (or data just collected) by October 23rd?
