ORDINANCE NO. 4017

ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE, PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 1.1.6 AND 2.4.1 OF THE CHEYENNE UNIFIED DEVELOPMENT CODE ("UDC"), AMENDING SECTION 6.5.5.b. TO ADD EXEMPTIONS FROM THE SIGN PERMIT REQUIREMENTS OF ARTICLE 6.5 OF THE UDC RELATING TO SIGNS."

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF CHEYENNE, WYOMING:

Section 1. That on December 5, 2011, the Cheyenne Planning Commission unanimously recommended approval of the "Cheyenne Unified Development Code."

Section 2. That on January 23, 2012, the Governing Body of the City of Cheyenne unanimously approved the Unified Development Code (Ordinance No. 3943) with an effective date of April 30, 2012.

Section 3. That on October 21, 2013, the City of Cheyenne Planning Commission recommended certain amendments to the UDC which are generally referred to as "election sign fixes."

Section 4. That UDC Section 6.5.5.b., Exemptions, is amended by adding two additional paragraphs as follows:

15. Signs which are easily placed and removed from the ground or building without needing additional structures, construction, or specialized equipment which relate to a candidate, issue, proposition, ordinance or other matter to be voted upon by the electors of the city.

16. Signs which are easily placed and removed from the ground or building without needing additional structures, construction, or specialized equipment which convey a philosophical, religious, political, charitable or other similar noncommercial message.

Section 5. Sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this Ordinance are severable. If any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases.

Section 6. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its approval and publication.
