Jim Walter, Chairman, called the meeting to order at 12:00 pm.

### Approval of Minutes

- The committee approved the March and April meeting minutes unanimously.

### Engineering & Project Updates

- No projects reported by Engineering or County Public Works.
- Jeanie said City Traffic Engineer Rick Amen, is updating or adding Greenway crossing and stop bar markings with other Engineering projects. The estimate is 15K to restripe W. 9<sup>th</sup> Street & Deming, Powderhouse & Gardenia, Morrie & E. Fox Farm, Short Road, Whitney & Countryside, Hitching Post Lane near Foster.

### Maintenance Update

- No major issues reported. General maintenance ongoing. It was reported that the US 30 underpass stayed dry after the large rain that happened a week ago

### Greenway Project Updates

#### Parsley Blvd and I-80 Overpass Greenway Connector

- Jeanie said the project is currently being reviewed by the City. Plans should be approved by the end of June. The cost estimate is not ready yet. This might be a great one to get done this fall or next spring.

#### Burlington Trail Greenway Connector

- Jeanie said Burlington Trail Road and Greenway are currently being constructed. Approximately half of the trail, from Campstool Road to the Interstate overpass, was completed a few weeks ago. Jeanie showed photos of the project.

### **Windmill Greenway Replacement**

- Jeanie reported that the city is replacing the old asphalt GW along Windmill. The Engineering Dept. added the project to a contract for concrete removal and replacement. The total cost should be \$236,622.00.

### **West Crow Creek Greenway Plan, MPO**

- Jeanie stated that there is a Public Open House scheduled for 5-7pm, Thursday, July 10<sup>th</sup> at the Laramie County Library, Cottonwood Room. She said she would send further information via email. Jim asked about PFA's found during the Crow Creek Revival project. Jeanie said that most of the Greenway would be placed along the road and not in the creek.

### **LCCC Underpass**

- Jeanie said that Marc Meadowcroft, a local graffiti artist, is interested in painting the art niches at LCCC and proposed a cost of \$1,700.00 to complete all five. Nancy and Jo said that we should ask him to come to a meeting and have him provide some sketches of what he is proposing.

### **MPO & Transportation Updates**

#### **West Crow Creek Greenway**

- Public meetings planned for July 10th.

#### **Safe Routes to School**

- Waiting to finalize update to the contract.

### **Greenway Foundation Updates**

- Nancy reported that the Spring into Green Event had 56 entrants. Jo said the Foundation made around \$2600. T-shirts are selling for \$13 on the Foundation website.

### **Other Business**

- **Bike to Work Day/Week – Brandon**

Brandon said Bike to Work Day is scheduled for Weds. June 25<sup>th</sup>. There will be breakfast stations in different parts of town and an after-work party from 5 to 9 pm at Freedom's Edge. He is also planning a kid's bike rodeo.
