## SALES TAX COMPARISON OVERVIEW

## December 2022 versus December 2023 Analysis

The City's state sales tax collections payment for December 2023 that was received in February was $\$ 2,648,338$ or $\$ 370,993$ more in revenue than the same time last year. On page 4 , you will see a table that shows the variations by category of more than $\$ 15,000$ in sales taxes collected in Laramie County, comparing December 2022 to 2023.

The most significant sales tax differences year-over-year that are greater or less than $\$ 100,000$ are as follows:

- Electronic Shopping and Mail-order Houses. Sales tax for this industry increased by $\$ 643,711$ in December 2023 compared to December 2022. This industry comprises establishments primarily engaged in retailing all types of merchandise using non-store means, such as catalogs, toll free telephone numbers, or electronic media, such as interactive television or computer.
- Power Generation and Supply. This industry group comprises establishments primarily engaged in generating, transmitting, and/or distributing electric power. Sales tax for this industry increased by \$360,536 compared to December 2022.
- Machinery and Equipment Rental and Leasing. Sales tax for this industry increased by $\$ 183,180$ compared to last December. This industry group comprises establishments primarily engaged in renting or leasing commercial-type and industrial-type machinery and equipment.
- Electrical Equipment Manufacturing. This industry group comprises establishments primarily engaged in manufacturing equipment that generates and distributes electrical power. Sales tax for this industry has increased by \$143,844 compared to the same time last year.
- Other Miscellaneous Store Retailers. Sales tax for this industry increased by $\$ 106,593$ in December 2023. This industry group comprises establishments primarily engaged in retailing new miscellaneous specialty store merchandise (except motor vehicle and parts dealers; furniture and home furnishings stores; consumer-type electronics and appliance stores; building material and garden equipment and supplies dealers; food and beverage stores; health and personal care stores; gasoline stations; clothing and clothing accessories stores; sporting goods, hobby, book, and music stores; general merchandise stores; florists; office supplies, stationery, and gift stores; and used merchandise stores).
