BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF CHEYENNE WYOMING:

<u>Section 1</u>. That Chapter 2.52, Personnel Commission, of Title 2, Administration and Personnel, of the code of the City of Cheyenne, Wyoming, is hereby repealed in its entirety as set out in this ordinance.

Chapter 2.52 PEDSONNEL COMMISSION

PERSONNEL COMMISSION		
2.52.010 Establishment and purpose.		
A. The city establishes a personnel commission to be known as the "Cheyenne personnel commission." Rules and regulations of the commission are on file with the office of city clerk.		
B. The purpose of the commission will be to:		
1. Provide reasonable interpretation of the city personnel (employee) rules and regulations adopted in accordance with the Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act, Wyo. Stat. Sections 16-3-101 et seq.;		
2. Hear and decide grievances of any eligible city employee;		
3. Fulfill all duties and responsibilities of the commission;		
4. Make recommendations to the governing body which it deems proper.		
2.52.020 Powers and duties.		
A. Duties:		
1. To conduct hearings as necessary to accomplish the purposes and provisions of the commission;		
2. To advise the mayor and members of city council on matters of personnel policies and problems of personnel administration and make related recommendations.		
B. Powers:		
1. To adopt rules and regulations pursuant to the Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act, Wyo. Stat. Sections 16-1-101 et seq., setting forth the commission's duties and responsibilities;		
 Receive and make decisions on disciplinary actions and grievances properly filed with the commission by eligible employees as clarified in the city personnel rules and regulations; 		
3. To affirm, modify or reverse any disciplinary action properly brought		

before the commission.

<u>Section 2</u>. That a new Chapter 2.52, Personnel System, of Title 2, Administration and Personnel, of the code of the City of Cheyenne, Wyoming, is hereby created as set out in this ordinance.

Chapter 2.52 PERSONNEL SYSTEM

2.52.010 Regulations and benefits.

Unless otherwise provided by law or contract, officers and employees of the city are governed by the city personnel (employee) rules and regulations on file in the offices of human resources and the city clerk.

- A. Changes to the city personnel (employee) rules and regulations shall be in accordance with the Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act, Wyo. Stat. Sections 16-3-101, et seq.
- B. Any employee appeal from administrative decisions regarding city personnel (employee) rules and regulations must be filed with and pursuant to established procedures of Chapter 2.92, Administrative Hearing Procedure. This procedure does not apply to grievance procedures prior to an appeal.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon adoption of new personnel rules.
