ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE, PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 1.1.6 AND 2.4.1(b) OF THE CHEYENNE UNIFIED DEVELOPMENT CODE (UDC), AMENDING ARTICLE 6, DESIGN REGULATIONS, SECTION 6.5.8, BILLBOARDS, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING WHICH ZONING DISTRICTS ALLOW BILLBOARDS."

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF CHEYENNE, WYOMING:

Section 1. That, pursuant to Sections 1.1.6 and 2.4.1(b) of the Cheyenne Unified Development Code (UDC), Article 6, Design Regulations, Section 6.5.8, Billboards, is hereby amended as follows:

- a. Billboards shall be permitted only in the MUB, CB, LI and HI zoning districts, except as provided in subsections (d) or (e).
- Section 2. That subsequent subsections currently outlined in Section 6.5.8. are hereby alphabetically re-lettered due to the insertion of new subsection (a) above.
- Section 3. That the word "issues" contained in former Subsection 6.5.8 (e), to be re-lettered as (f), be corrected to "issued", and the word "digitial" contained in the first line of former Subsection 6.5.8 (f), to be re-lettered as (g), be corrected "digital".
- Section 4. That sections and subsections currently existing in Section 6.5.8 not amended as set out within this ordinance remain unchanged.
- Section 5. That sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this ordinance are severable. If any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance is declared unconstitutional, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, and phrases.

Section 6. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its approval and publication.
