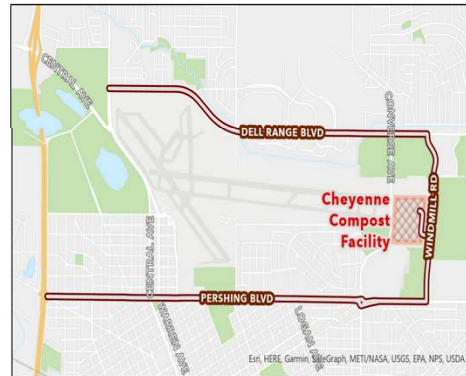
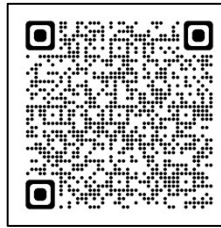

### Facility Rules

- Leave no trash or plastic bags. Empty and remove all bags and boxes.
- Obtain license plate number to report any inappropriate activity, 307-632-5518
- **Site Manager reserves the right to refuse drop-off of any load.**



- Children and Pets must remain in vehicles.
- There will be a fee of \$5.00 per cubic yard to drop off manure from businesses or residents in excess of 3 cubic yards.

## Materials

### Residential Pricing Drop-Off

There is NO CHARGE to residents dropping off yard waste to the Compost Facility. Section 8.44.070 of the City Code requires all persons transporting refuse or recyclable material must cover the load with a tarp or tie down with load straps.

### Materials Accepted

- Limbs and brush
- Tree trunks cut less than 6' in length & less than 10" in diameter
- Grass Clippings, prunings, and weeds
- Leaves
- Manure
- **NO ROOT BALLS OR ROOTS (TRANSFER STATION FEES APPLY)**

### NO SALES ON SUNDAYS

## Product Descriptions & Cost

	5 GALLON	CUBIC YARD
<b>Buffalo Chip Compost</b>	<b>\$.78</b>	<b>\$27.46</b>
Produced from composted manure and stable bedding materials, leaves, grass clippings, and ground wood. Used to increase water holding capacity and improve soil structure when planting trees, grass, and bedding plants. Also used to top-dress existing turf grass, potted, and bedding plants and to provide soil nutrients, organics, and beneficial microbes. Use as a soil preparation for new sod and transplants into beds or pots.		
<b>*Single Grind Mulch</b>	<b>\$.37</b>	<b>\$12.48</b>
Wood chip mulch produced from ground brush and limbs. Use as a decorative cover around trees, shrubs, and other plants to hold in moisture and limit growth of grass and weeds.		
<b>*Double Grind Mulch</b>	<b>\$.47</b>	<b>\$16.64</b>
Wood chip mulch ground extra fine. Used for decorative mulch cover and natural weed barrier.		
<b>Prepared Topsoil</b>	<b>\$.94</b>	<b>\$32.76</b>
Screened topsoil blended with Buffalo Chip Compost. Primarily used directly into your flower boxes, planters, pots, new sod, and seed areas (eliminates the need for blending compost and topsoil).		

**\*These items are currently free of charge but are subject to change.**

- Approximately 200 gallons equal to one cubic yard
- One level, long bed, full-size pickup truck load equals 2.5 cubic yards.
- We are happy to load all bulk volume sales into open top trucks and trailers with our loader.
