## ***New year reminders!***

**Holiday schedules:** If a holiday falls on a Monday collections will be as followed Monday slides to Tuesday, Tuesday to Wednesday, Wednesday to Thursday, and Thursday to Friday.

When a holiday is on Wednesday (Monday and Tuesday will not be affected)

Wednesday slides to Thursday, Thursday slides to Friday.

**Recycling lid locks:** Since recycling cannot be bagged we offer a lid lock for recycling containers available for purchase through the sanitation division. Call today to schedule your lid lock installation!

**Recycle Coach:** This is an app you can download for free that shows your pickup days. You can set up reminders, report a damaged container or missed pickup, and it reflects the holiday schedule!

**Bagging Trash:** All trash needs to be in a tied bag. This helps to reduce the amount of scattered trash within the city and at the landfill. When a container is blown over by the wind having your trash in a tied bag will prevent the trash from scattering.

**Household hazardous waste:** Items such as electronics, microwaves, oil-based paints, batteries, gas, oil, antifreeze, pesticides, etc DO NOT belong in your trash or recycle containers. Instead, we ask that you bring them to the Transfer Station to the household hazardous waste building. Hours are listed above.

**Recyclables:** Newspaper, junk mail, magazines, etc, brown paper bags, clean cardboard (flatten and cut to 2' x 2' or smaller), cereal boxes, aluminum foil or tin cans clean and empty, plastic containers & to go cups (#1,2,4, & 5), food and beverage grade glass (brown, clear, or green)

**Non – recyclable items:** Plastic bags, to-go boxes, bakery or fruit containers (even if they are #1, 2, or 5), Pizza boxes contaminated with food or grease, Styrofoam, yard waste, bubble wrap, hoses, cords, wood, clothes, plastic utensils, paper towels, paper plates and cups, coated cardboard.

\*Or any items that are not listed in the above recyclables list
