**Residential alley collection for trash
& recycle:** Please ensure your
containers have a 2ft clearance from
utility poles, sheds, garages,
wood/concrete block/vinyl/chain link
fences, vehicles, trailers, etc.

Holiday slide schedule means if a
holiday falls any day before or on
your weekly scheduled pickup you

**Acceptable Yard
Waste materials:**
Lawn trimmings,
weeds, leaves,
pine needles, and
pinecones **only!**

Please **NO** bags, branches (or
other woody materials), dirt,
rocks, pet waste, sod, or
mulch in yard waste
containers

Newer recyclable items:

To-go cups paper
or plastic (emptied)
Pizza boxes (with
minimal grease
residue)

Have yard waste
loosely in your
container. Use a
broom handle, shovel,
rake, etc. to loosen
packed yard waste in
your container.

Call to be placed on
the next available
branch pickup or bring
your branches to the
Compost Facility at
3714 Windmill Rd. free
of charge for Laramie
County residents.

Trash should **always**
be bagged.
Please remember yard
waste including
branches, lawn
trimmings, and leaves
are **not allowed** in
your trash or recycle
containers even if its
bagged!

**Electronics, batteries,
and hazardous
materials are not
allowed in ANY** of our
containers.
