ORDINANCE NO.

ENTITLED: AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING MONEYS FOR THE CITY OF CHEYENNE, WYOMING FOR THE VARIOUS PURPOSES IN CONDUCTING THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF SAID CITY AND FIXING THE AMOUNT OF GENERAL AND SPECIAL TAXES AS PART OF THE REVENUE REQUIRED TO MEET THE SAID APPROPRIATION, ALL FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2025, AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2026.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF CHEYENNE, WYOMING:

Section 1. That the sum of two hundred three million, six hundred and forty-six thousand, five hundred and sixty-six dollars (\$203,646,566) or so much thereof that may be necessary, and the same hereby is appropriated for all funds of the City of Cheyenne, for the several specific departments, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2025, and ending June 30, 2026, as follows:
