ENTITLED: "A RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF CHEYENNE, WYOMING AND THE CITY OF LOURDES, FRANCE ESTABLISHING A SISTER CITY BOND BETWEEN THE TWO CITIES."

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the City of Cheyenne, Wyoming, and the Mayor of the City of Lourdes, France, mutually endorse the effort to establish a sister city bond between the two cities, and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Cheyenne has launched its support of the conception of a sister city bond with Lourdes, France, and

WHEREAS, Cheyenne and Lourdes possess similarities in that Cheyenne is the home of the world's largest outdoor rodeo and Lourdes is the home of the first Pyreneam Championship Rodeo, and

WHEREAS, it would greatly benefit both cities to partake in deliberation to build, create and generate growth and development of the two cities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Body of the City of Cheyenne, Wyoming, that the elected body representing the people of the City of Cheyenne hereby recognizes Lourdes, France as a sister city.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall be effective upon passage and be spread on the records of the City of Cheyenne as a permanent record and that a copy thereof be forwarded to the Mayor of Lourdes, France.
