## **PUT RECYCLABLES IN THEIR PLACE**

### What can go in recycling?

The following items are **ALLOWED** in your container :

- Paper products: newspapers, books, junk mail, magazines, etc.
- Brown paper bags
- Clean cardboard (flatten & cut into 2'x2' pieces or smaller)
- Cereal Boxes
- Aluminum foil or tin cans empty
- Plastic containers (#1, #2, #4 & #5)
- Glass food and beverage containers brown, clear, or green empty

All Recyclables must be dry, clean, and loose (not bagged)

### **Program Details**

- Residences are provided blue lidded containers for recyclables. <u>Please place items</u> <u>in their appropriate container</u>. **Recyclables may NOT be bagged**.
- Rinse containers that have food particles or liquids; (Plastic juice/milk bottles) before placing in container.
- For oily contaminants, please wash with soap before placing with recyclables.
- Cardboard boxes cannot have any food particles or oil stains; for example pizza boxes are not accepted. Large boxes must be flattened and cut into pieces 2ft x 2ft or smaller to fit loosely in the container
- Lid locks can be added to the recycle container for a fee. To add a lid lock to your container please call 307-637-6440
- Effective February 1, 2025, Sanitation will begin a four-day week residential collection schedule (Monday through Thursday)
- Observed holidays will now be on a "slide" schedule meaning waste collection now "slides" to the next day.

#### \*Place containers at least 2 ft or more away from curb, driveway, vehicles or any other object no later than 6:00am on the day of pick up or



# What cannot go in recycling?

- Plastic bags and bagged materials (even if containing recyclables)
- Shredded paper
- Mirrors
- Plexi-glass, flower pots, plastic totes
- Garbage
- Styrofoam
- Glass & metal cookware/bakeware
- Light Blubs
- Ceramics
- Straws or fast food packaging
- Porcelains and ceramics
- Hoses, cords, wires
- Flexible plastics or film packaging and multilaminated materials
- Food waste & liquids, containers containing such items
- Window or auto glass
- Coated cardboard (ex. juice boxes)
- Plastics #3, #6, #7 and unnumbered
- Coat Hangers
- Household appliances and electronics
- Yard waste, construction debris, and wood
- To-go boxes, bakery, or fruit containers (even though they have a #1,2, or 5 on them)
- Frozen dinner trays
- Needles, syringes, IV bags or other medical supplies
- Textiles, cloth, or any fabrics
- Napkins, paper towels, tissues, paper plates, paper cups, and plastic utensils
- Propane tanks, batteries
