ENTITLED: "A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE NAMING OF A LOS ANGELES CLASS SUBMARINE THE U.S.S. CHEYENNE."

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Cheyenne finds that the City of Cheyenne would be honored to have the SSN 688 class submarine named after this historic and vital community and,

WHEREAS, the City of Cheyenne has been a supporter of our nation's defense since the days of the opening of the West and,

WHEREAS, Cheyenne's frontier spirit, determination, and support for our country's military establishment has been demonstrated for well over one hundred years and,

WHEREAS, the State of Wyoming will be celebrating it's centennial in 1990 and the christening of a U.S. submarine after the Capitol City would be a fitting birthday present for the people of the State of Wyoming and the City of Cheyenne and,

WHEREAS, a ship of the fleet was named after Cheyenne in the early part of the 1900's but due to a change of policy the Cheyenne was renamed the U.S.S. Wyoming.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF CHEYENNE, WYOMING:

That the Governing Body of the City of Cheyenne requests that the Department of the Navy give special consideration to naming one of it's Los Angeles class submarines the U.S.S. Cheyenne, and be it further resolved,


